Nurture in the Lord

Col 3:21 Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.

Diligently teach - Provide opportunities for learning about God - Shepherd their hearts

Deu 6: 4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: 5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. 6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: 7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Teach by example

Deu 6:17 Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee. 18 And thou shalt do that which is right and good in the sight of the LORD: that it may be well with thee...



Teach by example continued

Acknowledge wrongs to children. We cannot expect them to confess their sins if they do not see us confessing ours. They know, so we may as well clear things up with them for our good and for theirs.

Extend forgiveness to them. This demonstrates to them how our heavenly Father extends His forgiveness to us.

Ps 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.
